Castle Stories

700 years of castle history come alive. The view into the old well is almost as exciting as the ascent of the old north tower. As a souvenir, we draw or print a picture of the castle. Weatherproof clothing required!

Learning content: precise observation, descriptive seeing, making hypotheses about the historical use of the castle, life in the Middle Ages, orientation in the landscape, presentation of complex forms, drawing from the object

Interactive Guided Tour: Who Was Joseph Beuys?

Joseph Beuys, who worked with the most diverse materials, was one of the most important German artists. Many of his works can be found in the Museum Schloss Moyland. They amaze us; they are at times inexplicable, at other times quite strange, and then again very close. Let's talk about them and walk in the footsteps of Beuys.

Learning content: Basic knowledge of Joseph Beuys, precise observation, descriptive seeing

Printmaking

In this workshop, you can print your own cards for sending or giving away. If desired, your own motifs (e.g. greeting cards) or motifs from the museum can be printed in colour.

Learning content: Introduction to the technique of relief printing, logical thinking, mirror-inverted drawing, experimenting

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Sculpture Pure

Lines, circles, triangles? Or what does a head really look like? After a guided tour through the art collection, we will make our own sculpture of a head and experience the proportions of a face.

Learning content: precise observation, descriptive seeing, facial proportions and expressions, training of fine motor skills, logical thinking, basic knowledge of sculpture, acting according to a set plan

Art Camp

We build huts from sticks, branches, and cord. To be successful, it is important that everyone recognises and contributes his or her own strengths. We then decorate our huts with natural art.

Learning content: cooperation training, proceeding according to a set plan, dendrology, building with natural materials

The fee for a workshop is 6.50 € per pupil in a class group. The accompanying adults have free admission.
